<p>News report</p> <p><u>New Brighton Cadet Killed</u></p> <p>Midshipman Frederick Arthur Vladimir Wevill, R.N., was killed in the explosion which occurred on H.M.S. Vanguard on July 9th, aged 16. He joined the battleship on May 7. Passing with honours from the training ship Conway, where he won the King's Prize for general efficiency, he proceeded to Dartmouth, and passed 19th out of 100 cadets. He was the eldest son of Mrs. A.E. Wevill, "The Slopes," New Brighton. His uncle, Major Harold Millard, Northamptonshire Regiment, was killed on April 10.</p>
