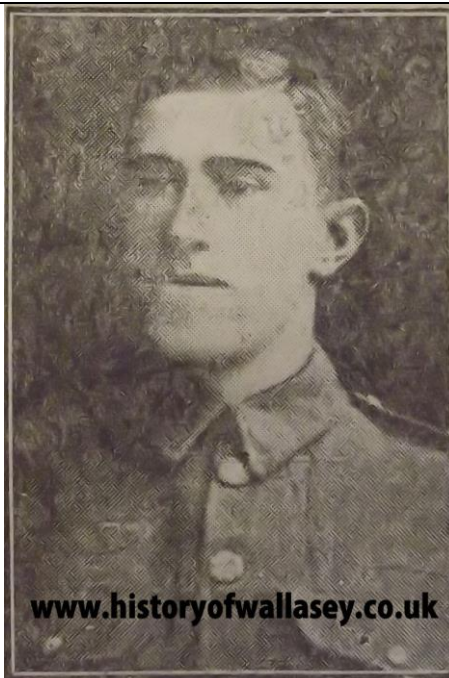

Postman Wounded And Missing  
(April 1918)

Pte. John Edward Wharton, King's Shropshire Light Infantry, has been reported wounded and missing since March 22. He is 26 years of age and joined the colours on March 30, 1916, and went to France in September of the same year. He was educated at St. Paul's School, and was a postman at Rake Lane P.O. Any news concerning him will be gratefully received by his father, Mr. J. Wharton, 33, Florence Road, Seacombe.
