News Report

Ferry Employee Killed

Official notification has been received by telegram stating that Sub-Lieut. Thomas White, R.N.V.R., was killed in action during operations in France on December 28, 1917. He joined up on September 6th, 1914, and went through the Gallipoli campaign, and afterwards was drafted to France. He came home in January, 1917, for his commission. He was formerly employed on Wallasey Ferries, and was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry White, 7, Beaconsfield Road, Seacombe. His wife resides at 32, St. Alban's Road, Liscard.
