Seacombe Soldier Dies From Wounds

The sad intelligence has been received that Private Thomas Ernest (Ernie) Wilbraham, of the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment, died from wounds on Sept. 22. He joined the colours in October of last year, and was drafted to France on Whit-Monday. The gallant soldier, who was only 19 years of age, received his early education at Riverside Council School, and completed his studies at the Wallasey Grammar School. He was formerly employed as clerk with the Aveco Cereal Co., Liverpool, and was a member of the Montrose football team. He was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. T. Wilbraham, 34, Littledale Road, Egremont.
