#### News Report

##### A Noble Death

The name of Private Harry J. Wilcox has to be added to the list of local members of the Liverpool Scottish who fell in the gallant charge at Hooze.

The news has just reached the parents at "Home Lea", Manor Lane, Liscard. One of the members of the regiment, writing, says :-

"... Harry went under during the charge made by us on June 16th, but I am sure it will console you greatly to know in your sorrow that he died a noble death doing his duty. I send sincerest sympathy to all in your great loss."

Private Harry Wilcox was 28 years of age and joined the Liverpool Scottish in November, being drafted to the front at the commencement of February. His brother, Mr. [P.E. Wilcox](#), is a sergeant in the 13th Cheshires.
