News Report

Seacombe Lad Falls At The Dardanelles

Official news was received yesterday morning by his parents at 54, Hatherley Street, Seacombe, of the death of Private Bertie Williams, of the 4th Cheshires. The shock was all the greater because on Monday the parents received a letter from their lad saying he was in the best of health. This was dated September 16, and the young fellow was killed three days later in the Dardanelles. Young Williams joined the Cheshires twelve months before the outbreak of war and was 19 years of age. He was educated at St. Mary's School, Liscard., and was a member of the United Methodists Bible Class in St. Paul's Road, Seacombe.
