News Report

Liscard Butcher's Manager Killed

Information has been received that Gunner Charles Edwin Williams, R.F.A., was killed in action on April 22. He leaves a widow and a boy to mourn his loss. He joined on October 28, 1916, and went to France in April, 1917. He was formerly manager for you Mr. W.H. Wood, butcher, 109, Wallasey Road. He was the eldest son of Mr and Mrs Charles Williams, 49, Merton Road, Liscard, where his wife also resides. Three other sons are In the Army, one in Palestine, another in Salonika, and the other is in training.

2nd. Lieut. T.H. Greenslade writes:-

"You will no doubt be glad to know that his death was sudden and that he suffered no pain, and also that we brought him out of the fighting line and buried him with others who fell at the same time with full military honours. The Battery Commander also wishes to express with me our great regret at our

mutual loss, and alos our appreciation of your husband's worth whilst serving with us in the battery."
