Wallasey Baker Killed

News has been received by Mr and Mrs Williams, of Heath Bank, Breck Road, Wallasey, that their son, Pte. J. Williams, aged 19 years, died of wounds on April 14th. The deceased soldier, who enlisted in April 1917, was put into the Manchester Regiment after serving a short time with T.R.B., but he was subsequently transferred to the King's Liverpool Regiment. Before enlistment he was employed with Messrs. Hamilton Bros., bakers. Wallasey, and was also a member of the Wallasey Parish Church, where a memorial service is contemplated. He was educated at St. George's Road Council School.
