Corporation Employee Missing

Private John Henry Williams, son of Mr. Williams, 5 Valkyrie Road, has been reported missing since July. He enlisted in the Cheshires at the outbreak of war, and has previously been wounded, having been in France for twelve months. He is 21 years of age, and was employed at the Water Department of the Wallasey Corporation. His parents would be very grateful for any further information of their missing son.

Bombing Comrades Killed

News has this week [Feb.1917] been received of the fate of Wallasey lads who have been officially notified as missing since the attacks of last July.

Mr. and Mrs. John Williams, of 5, Valkyrie Road, Liscard, have received the sad news that their son, Pte. John H. Williams, of the Cheshire Regt., has been killed in action. He was previously reported missing after an engagement on July 7th, when several of his regiment made the great sacrifice. He was educated at St. Mary's School, and was employed by the Corporation in the Gas and Water Department. The deceased soldier was a bomber.
