An Only Son

Official news has been received that Private S.E. (Sam) Williams, Cheshire Regt., was killed in action on February 17. Only 21 years of age, he joined up in December, 1915, and had been in France since June, 1916. He was educated at Wallasey Grammar School, and entered the services of Messrs. E. Billington and Sons, Ltd., Stanley Street, Liverpool. He was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. G.T.H. Williams, "Firville," Magazine Lane, New Brighton, to whom much sympathy has been extended in the irreparable loss they have sustained.
