He was educated at St. Peter's, Liverpool, and attended St. Alban's Church, Liscard. He enlisted in February, 1917, and was drafted to France last October. Private Wilson, who was only 19 years of age, resided with his parents at 65, Rice Lane, Egremont. Two of his brothers have been discharged from the Army.</p> | |
