<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Liscard Sergeant Fate</u></p> <p><u>Killed Whilst Leading His Platoon</u></p> <p>As was briefly intimated in our last Saturday's issue, Sergeant Norman McCaull Wilson, of the Liverpool Regiment, who resided with his widowed mother at "Blairmore," 51, Radnor Drive, Liscard, was killed in action on August 9th. The sad news was first intimated to Mrs. Wilson through the medium of a stretcher-bearer comrade, who stated that "Norman was killed whilst leading his platoon into action." Official confirmation has since, unhappily, been forthcoming.</p> <p>In civil life the fallen soldier was employed by Messrs. Williams, Wilson and Co., Liverpool, cotton merchants, and his work was such that necessitated periodical journeys to Texas. His death will be deeply deplored.</p>
