Liscard Canadian's Death

Former Tower Amateurs' Footballer

The death is now announced of Private Alan Woffenden (32), of the Canadian Infantry, who was officially posted as missing since April 29th of this year. The War Office notification, under date September 20th, says that he was killed at St. Eloi on the 20th April.

Prior to his emigration to Vancouver some ten years ago, Private Woffenden resided at 24, Grosvenor Street, Liscard. A former member of the Memorial Church, Manor Road, he was educated at the Wallasey Grammar School, where he also gained no little distinction as an athlete. He later played football for the New Brighton Tower Amateurs
