Killed In Action

A letter has been received from Quartermaster Martin by the Committee of the Gala Fund for sending parcels, stating that Private Edwin Wood, of the Wallasey Pals, the husband of Mrs. Alice Wood, of 6 Kelvin Road, Seacombe, has been killed in action. He was formerly employed at Messrs. Edmunds Taylor and Co., timber merchants, of Egremont.

Previously Reported Missing

(Feb 1917)

Mrs Alice Wood, of 6, Kelvin Road, Seacombe has now received official

intimation that her husband, Private Edwin Wood, of the Cheshire Regiment, was killed in action on July 7th 1916. He was previously reported "missing believed killed" about this time last year.

Before enlistment Private Wood was employed by Messrs Edmunds Taylor and Co., the Egremont firm of timber merchants. By a tragic coincidence, he joined up with his next door neighbour, [Private George Fletcher](#) of 8, Kelvin Road, who was also posted as "Missing, believed killed," on the same day.
