News Report

Sergeant Instructor Killed

Mrs Wood, of 24, Barrington Road, Seacombe, has received the sad intelligence of the death of her husband, Pte. James Wood, Royal Welsh Fusiliers, who was killed in action on Sept. 3rd. He was 28 years of age, and joined the colours on August 4, 1915, and had been in France since December, 1916. He was formerly sergeant-instructor in the Denbigh Hussars Yeomanry, and attached to the R.W.F. when he was drafted to France. For nine months he acted as instructor, Second Army School of Musketry. He was educated at Andrew Higher Grade Public School and Training College, Gray's school of Art and Classes at Aberdeen University, and was employed with Messrs. Milligan and Macintosh, cotton brokers, Exchange Buildings, Liverpool.
