Twenty-six years of age, he enlisted November 1915, and had been in France since last February. He was the eldest son of the Mrs. Eliza Wood, and the late Mr. George Wood, 97, Craven Street, Birkenhead. The Major of his Battery writing to his widow, who is left with a baby, residing at 14, Romeo Street, Poulton, expresses his deepest sympathy at the loss of so excellent a soldier.</p>
