An Only Son

Corpl. Harold Wright died on April 15 from wounds received in action on April 12. Only 19 years of age, he joined the "Pals" in 1915, when just over 16, and was made Lance-Corporal in September, 1916, when he was transferred to the Manchester Regt., and created a full Corporal on February 15, 1917, and was drafted to France with the Labour Corps Battalion, afterwards joining the Lancashire Regt. He was educated at Seacombe Wesleyan School, and was formerly a member of the Poulton Cadets. He was the only son of Mr and Mrs Percy Wright, 10, Florence Road, Seacombe.
