Private Abraham Allen, Loyal North Lancs., was reported missing on May 27, and afterwards a prisoner of war. Official news has now been received from the Central Prisoners of War association, London, that he died at Ramecourt, on July 24<sup>th</sup>. He was only 19 years of age, and educated at Riverside Council School. He joined the colours in May, 1916, and was drafted to France last April. He was the eldest son of Mrs. Allen, and of Mr Pte. Abraham Allen, who has been missing since March 23<sup>rd</sup>, of 15 Tabor Street, Seacombe.
