#### Shot By A Sniper

#### New Brighton Officer Killed

Lieutenant Michele Amoroso, son of the late Michele Amoroso, ship broker, Liverpool, and Mrs Amoroso, of Wellington Road, New Brighton, was killed in action on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. He joined the Liverpool Scottish at the outbreak of war, and after undergoing training in Edinburgh, received a commission in the R.F.A. He distinguished himself at the Battle of Loos, and was promoted to full Lieutenant. Lieutenant Amoroso manned a Lewis gun in order to pick off German snipers, who were worrying the infantry, and was killed himself by a sniper from about thirty yards distance. He was 24 years of age, and was educated at Stonyhurst College.
