## Seacombe Soldier Killed

We regret to announce the death if Pte. Emil Edward Anderson, of the Manchester Regiment, aged 19 years. He was of a cheery and affable disposition, and at the age of 17 years the brae lad joined the colours. He was sent to India on garrison duty for twelve months, and volunteered for action service. He had only been in Mesopotamia three weeks when he was killed in action, but no further particulars are forthcoming. He was an old St. Paul's boy, and employed by Messrs. Mawdesley and Son, printers, Liverpool. He attended Seacombe Presbyterian Church, and was a loyal member if the Sunday School. He was the second son of the late Sven Emil Anderson, and of Mrs. W.R. Guthrie, 12, Evelyn Road, Wallasey.

Three other sons are in the transport service, their step-father being chief engineer on a transport ship.
