

Liscard Grocer Killed

The sad intimation has been received that Pte. Samuel Andrew, Cheshire Regt., has been killed in action. He enlisted at the beginning of the war, had been over twelve months in France, and was previously in the shoulder and leg. He was educated at St. George's Council School, Wallasey, and employed with Messrs. H. Thompson and Sons Ltd., Liscard. He attended St. Thomas' Church and Sunday School. He was the only son of Mrs Phoebe Andrew, and of the late Mr A. Andrew, 11, Cecil Road, Wallasey Road. His wife and little girl reside at 11a, Seaview Avenue, Seaview Road, Liscard. He was 29 years of age.
