News Report

Harrier's Death From Pneumonia

We regret to record the death of Driver Frederick Norman Barlow, Royal Field Artillery, who died from pneumonia on November 2nd, at Wardown Military Hospital, Luton, at the age of 24. He joined the colours in January, 1916, and was drafted at the end of the same year. He was admitted to hospital, in Nottingham, last May, and rejoined his depot, waiting for his discharge when he was struck down with the "flu," and passed away. He was educated at the Liverpool College, Shaw Street, and was in the service of Messrs. Simpson, Roberts, and Co., provision merchants, Liverpool. He was a member of the Wallasey Harriers, and won the novice championship for Cross Country running, during the season if 1914. He was a keen footballer, and was awarded several certificates for swimming and other prizes for sports generally. He was the youngest son of Mr and Mrs C. Barlow, "Balgownie," Montpellier Crescent, New Brighton.
