

## Killed In Action

The sad official news has been received that Private Harold Barrow, Worcestershire Regiment, was killed in action on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. He was in his 22<sup>nd</sup> year, and enlisted three years ago, having been twice wounded. He had served at the time of of the rebellion in Ireland before proceeding to France, where he had only been with his Battalion since the 13<sup>th</sup> of August. He was educated at Somerville Council School, and attended Oakdale Presbyterian Mission, and was also a member of the football and cricket clubs. He was the fifth son of Mrs. E. Barrow, and of the late Mr. J. Barrow, 27 Naples Road, Seacombe. He was formerly employed as baker with Messrs. Leitch and Lucas, Rake Lane, Liscard.
