The Third Son

In our issue of last Saturday we reported that Pte. <u>John Bennett</u>, Cheshire Regt., aged 26 years, died from wounds received in action in France on April 3. Also that Pte. <u>Edward Bennett</u>, Cheshire Regt., aged 22 years, has been "missing" since July 31, 1917. It is our painful duty to announce that another bereavement has befallen the family, by the sad news that that has been received that Rifleman William Bennett, King's Liverpool Regt., has paid the supreme sacrifice. The brave soldier was killed at his post on April 9.* He was the eldest son of Mrs. Mary Bennett, 7 Cedar Grove, Poulton. He leaves a widow and one child, to whom the greatest sympathy has been extended.
