The sad intelligence has been received that Gunner George Bent, R.G.A., was hit by a shell and died on his way to the dressing station on Saturday, the 9th inst. He was educated at Somerville Council School, and previous to enlisting in May of last year, was employed on the Wallasey Ferries, and was drafted to France last September.
