News Report <u>Egremont Lieutenant Killed</u> News has been received of the death of Lieut. J.H. Betteridge, the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. T.H. Betteridge of 68, Clarendon Road, Egremont, who was killed in a recent action. The gallant officer, who was 35 years of age, was educated at the Wallasey Grammar School. He lived for 14 years in Natal and Portuguese East Africa, and was in business in Laurence Marques. On the outbreak of war he responded to his country's call, came home and joined the O.T.C. He received a commission in the Border Regt., and was attached to the Queen's Westminster Rifles (London Regt.)
