Seacombe Man Killed

After the recent great advance in Flanders, Pte. James Blackburn, of the King's Royal Rifles, 6, Corbyn Street, Seacombe, I was among the missing. This week his wife received an official communication stating that he was dead - killed in action on September 25th. Thirty-seven years of age, Pte. Blackburn joined the Hussars when he was sixteen and for eight years saw Garrison duty in India. he took part at Mons being on active service from August 6th, 1914, till the time of his death.
