

News Report

<u>Liscard Postman Killed</u>

The death in action is officially reported of Pte. T. Broadhurst, of, 29, Liscard Grove, Liscard. The deceased, who was well-known in Liscard, having been employed as postman for 18 years was in the Cheshire Regt. (Machine Gun Section). He joined up in June, 1916, and went to France last October. He was connected with St. Thomas Church, Liscard, and was a member of the Wallasey Harriers, frequently taking part in their runs. He leaves a widow and three children.

The Chaplain, in a letter, to Mrs. Broadhurst, states that a shell fell as the company was leaving the trenches killing her husband instantly.

The Company officer writes of the deceased soldier:- "He was always a splendid soldier, and his good fellowship and cheerfulness endeared him to all."
