## New Brighton Man Killed

The sad intimation of her son's death in action has been received by Mrs. E. Burgess, of 41 Seafield Drive, New Brighton. Lance-Corporal Henry Burgess, who was killed on the 5<sup>th</sup> September, joined the Manchester Regiment in May 1917, and was transferred to the East Lancashire Regiment after going to France in April of this year. A letter from the chaplain states that the deceased soldier was being taken to the dressing station with a slight wound when he was killed. He was 19 years of age, and when at home attended St. Nicholas Church, Wallasey. He was employed by Messrs Williams Bros., grocers, New Brighton.
