## **Another Council Employee Killed**

Information has been received from the Rev. T. Harold Mousley, chaplain, of the death of Private Ernest James Glover, of the Cheshire Regiment, who passed away after a short illness in Mesopotamia. The deceased was the son of Mr and Mrs S.E. Glover, of 42, Green Lane, Egremont, and was 23 years of age. He joined the Cheshires at the outbreak of war, and took part in the fierce campaign which raged round historic parts of Gallipoli. He came out without a scratch, but dysentery held him in its grip for some four months. Coming from hospital, he was transferred to Mesopotamia, where he died. He was in the employ of the Wallasey Corporation, being an assistant ticket collector at the Egremont Ferry. As a lad he attended St. Mary's School, Liscard.
