There were several Wallasey men on board the Laurentic, whose relatives are anxiously awaiting news.

Another Wallaseyan on board, who has been officially reported by the Admiralty as among those who have lost their lives, was shipwright Robert Roger Godfrey, aged 31 years, the elder son of the late Captain W.B. Godfrey, of the Wallasey Ferry service. He was educated at St. Paul's Schools, Seacombe, and afterwards, apprenticed to Messr. Cammell, Laird and Co., Birkenhead. His mother, Mrs. E. Godfrey, with whom much sympathy will be felt, now lives at 4, James Street, Seacombe.
