Liscard Soldier Killed

Official notification has been received that Pte. James Grindrod, the third son of Mrs. Sarah Grindrod, of 10, Monk Road, Liscard, had been killed in action. The deceased soldier, who was 21 years of age, joined the Forces in February, 1916, and went out to Mesopotamia in the following May. He was killed on April 30th last. Before enlisting he was employed by the Pacific Steam Navigation Company. Mrs. Grindrod has two other sons serving in the Army, Pte. J.H. Grindrod, who is attached to the Canadian Field Artillery, and Pte. Jack Grindrod, who belongs to the Border Regt. News was received last week that the latter, who is in France, has been awarded the Military Medal.
