News Report

A Seacombe man, Sergeant James Andrew Harrison, of the Royal Marines, whose home address is 13, Hallville Road, is among those lost by the sinking of the cruiser Natal. Twenty-five years of age, Sergeant Harrison was a member of the ship's band and had been promoted from corporal since the outbreak of war. It is little more than two months ago since Sergeant Harrison lost his younger brother from typhoid after being wounded at Gallipoli while serving with the 8th Cheshires.
