News Report

Corporation Employee Killed

Mrs. Henshaw, of 2, St. Alban's Cottages, Liscard, has received a notification that her husband, Private Thomas Henshaw, has been killed in France. Private Henshaw, who was 41 years of age, joined the Army in October, last year, and three months later was sent to the front. He was attached to one of the Labour Battalions, and is reported to have been killed in action on Sept. 7. Before enlisting he was in the employ of the Health Department of the Wallasey Corporation for 19 years. His family are well known in the district, his mother, prior to her death recently, his mother, prior to her death recently, having lived at St. Alban's Cottages for 52 years. Two of his brothers, who were also in the employ of the Wallasey Corporation, are serving in the Army, one, a lance-corporal, having been wounded.
