Reported Killed

Pte. William Stanislaus O'Neill, Cheshire Regt., is officially reported as killed in action on the 21st of August. He enlisted in January, 1915, and had been two years in France. He was the youngest son of Mrs. A.J. O'Neill, 7 Mill Lane. Liscard. His late father, Mr. Henry O'Neill, was manager of the old Wallasey Tramway Co., and brother of Mr. J. O'Neill, formerly manager of the Liverpool Tramway Co.
