## Liscard Tradesman's Bereavement

The numerous friends of Sergt. Edward ("Teddy") Peirce, eldest son of Mr. E. Peirce, hairdresser, of Liscard Road, Liscard, will be grieved to hear of his death which took place in France whilst in action with his regiment, the 39<sup>th</sup> Batt. Canadian Field Artillery.

"Teddy," as he was familiarly known, was 35 years of age, and for many years assisted in his father's business at Liscard, and also managed the branch shop in Trafalgar Road, Egremont. He was an all-round athlete, and prior to leaving for Canada showed great interest in the Egremont Baptist Gymnasium and the Seacombe Swimming Club. It is interesting to note that Sergt.
