Egremont Cricketer Killed

We regret to record the death of Gunner Albert Price, R.G.A., aged 31 years, who was killed in action by a bursting shell on October 11. He joined up in April last, and had been six weeks in France. He was a popular member of the Egremont Cricket Club.
