##### Died From Wounds

The sad intelligence has been received of the death of 2<sup>nd</sup> Liuet. J.L. Quinlan, on December 28, 1917. He enlisted in the earliest days of the war in the King's Liverpool Regt., rapidly rose to the rank of Sergeant, and received his commission in August of last year and became attached to the Warwickshire Regt. Twenty-three years of age, he was educated at Wallasey Grammar School, and was formerly engaged by the Liverpool and Globe Insurance Company. He was the second son of Mrs. Quinlan, 7, Elmswood Road, Egremont.
