Liscard Soldier Killed In Action

Official news has just received at 9, Eldon Road. Liscard, of the death in action of Private George Reynolds, 9th Battalion Loyal North Lancashires. Private Reynolds, who is 34 year of age, was the eldest son of Colonel J.H. Reynolds, who distinguished himself during the Zulu War when he was awarded the Victoria Cross.
