

<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Accidentally Killed</u></p> <p>Pte. John Richards, Labour Corps, was killed on March 23, through the accident on a lorry caused by a train dashing into it. He enlisted in March, 1917, and had been six months in France. He was previously in the service of the Liverpool Cold Storage Oil Works. His wife and four children reside at 14, Portia Street, Poulton.</p>
